

Rules of the CIJM Photo Award

Mathematical look at water in all its states



On the occasion of the 14th Salon culture et jeux mathématiques, organized by the CIJM from the 30th of May to the 2nd of June 2013 at The Cité des sciences et de l'industrie, 30 avenue Corentin Cariou, Paris 19th (France), a photo award competition will be held entitled:

Mathematics of the Planet Earth

This is to celebrate the

International Year on Water Cooperation.

Rules :

Article 1 : the competition is open to everybody, it is free of charge.

Article 2 : the theme is :

Mathematical look at water in all its states

Article 3 : the photos, submitted to the jury, must be sent both digitally and on photographic paper in a size close to A4; they must be taken with a simple camera without any additional gear or any transformation. The family name,

first name, phone number, address of the submitter and the title of photo must be written on the back of the photo.

Article 4 : Each submission will contain just one photo, a stamped envelope to send it back if desired, in the case where the photo was not awarded. It will be enclosed in a strong envelope to the address :

Article 5 : The **deadline** The deadline is fixed for the **10th of May 2013**

Article 6 : The jury will be formed by one mathematician, one artist and two members of associations.

Article 7 : The jury will select 10 photos to be presented at the Salon culture et jeux mathématiques, from the 30th of

May to the 2nd of June 2013 at The Cité des sciences et de l'industrie, 30 avenue Corentin Cariou, Paris 19th (France) and will choose two jury awards (first and second award). The visitors will be invited to vote among the 10 photos presented, and two public awards (first and second award) will be given.

Article 8 : The awards will be announced at the salon, on the Sunday 2nd of June at the end of the afternoon, then they will be seen on the site of the CIJM :

Article 9 : The 10 selected photos will remain the property of the CIJM, which can use them, without profit making, in all exhibitions in which it participates. They could be published in a magazine.
